**FIXED INCOME** 

Global Economy: Job openings posted by US employers slipped 0.7% in May, while hires that month tumbled 4.4% in a sign that the job market may be easing slightly. The Labor Department said that employers posted 7.3 million jobs in May. They hired 5.7 million, down from the record 6 million hit in April. The pace of global economic growth remained stuck at a three-year low in June, according to the latest PMI surveys from IHS Markit, rounding off the worst quarterly expansion since the second quarter of 2016. The JPMorgan Global PMI, compiled by IHS Markit, held steady at 51.2 in June, signalling the slowest rate of expansion of global output since June 2016 during the past two months. Global demand for agricultural products is projected to grow by 15% over the coming decade, while agricultural productivity growth is expected to increase slightly faster, causing inflation-adjusted prices of the major agricultural commodities to remain at or below their current levels, according to an annual report by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development and the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization. UK like-for-like retail sales dropped by 1.6% in June as the uncertainty surrounding Brexit deterred people from spending on non-essential items. The figures from the British Retail Consortium and KPMG showed that total sales fell by 1.3%. Australia business confidence weakened in June after rising sharply in May, data from the National Australia Bank showed. The business confidence index fell 5 points to +2 in June and the decline was broad-based across industries.

Global Equities: The US stocks saw choppy moves ahead of upcoming Congressional testimony from the US Fed Chairman Jerome Powell. Powell is due to testify before the House Financial Services Committee on Wednesday and before the Senate Banking Committee on Thursday.

Indian Economy: Out of 1.03 crore houses sanctioned till 8.7.2019 under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G), 62.92 lakh landless beneficiaries, who derive major part of their income from manual casual labour, have been sanctioned houses. State Govt./UT Administrations, responsible to provide land to the landless, are yet to provide land to 3.26 lakh landless PMAY-G beneficiaries. Nirmala Sitharaman, Union Minister of Finance, addressed the Central Board of Directors of Reserve Bank of India. The Finance Minister outlined the thinking behind the Union Budget 2019 and the focus areas of the Government. The Finance Minister also highlighted the importance of coordination between the RBI and Government.

Equity Markets: The Sensex ended with small gains, while the Nifty ended almost flat after a volatile trading session. Union Budget proposal to impose higher taxes on the super-rich, tax share buybacks and increase minimum public shareholding in listed companies continued to weigh on investors sentiment. The Sensex rose 10.25 points or 0.03% to settle at 38,730.82. The Nifty 50 index fell 2.70 points or 0.02% to settle at 11,555.90.

Corporate News: IT major Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) reported a 10.8% year-on-year (YoY) rise in profit at Rs 8,131 crore for June quarter against Rs 7,340 crore in the same quarter last year. On a sequential basis, profit was marginally higher. Revenue for the quarter rose 11.4% YoY to Rs 38,172 crore, the company said in a BSE filing. Revenue growth in constant currency terms stood at 10.6% on a yearly basis. However, the operating margin came in at 24.2% against 25.1% in March quarter. The State Bank of India has been found flouting several rules in its attempt to cover up non-performing assets (NPAs), according to the RBI's annual inspection report. An agreement has been signed between BHEL and Container Corporation of India to form Joint Working Group to establish rail-based logistics terminal at Haridwar.
