Global Economy: The National Association of Realtors released a report showing another steep drop in U.S. existing home sales in the month of May. NAR said existing home sales plunged by 3.4 percent to an annual rate of 5.41 million in May after slumping by 2.6 percent to a revised rate of 5.60 million in April. Existing home sales fell for the fourth consecutive month. Meanwhile, totaling housing inventory surged by 12.6 percent to 1.16 million units at the end of May from 1.03 million units at the end of April. Housing inventory is still down by 4.1 percent compared to a year ago. New Zealand posted a merchandise trade surplus of NZ\$263 million in May, according to Statistics New Zealand. Exports were worth NZ\$6.95 billion last month, accelerating from the downwardly revised NZ\$6.16 billion in the previous month (originally NZ\$631 million). Imports came in at NZ\$6.69 billion, up from the downwardly revised NZ\$5.72 billion in April (originally NZ\$5.73 billion). The euro area current account deficit increased notably in April, largely due to the shortfalls in primary and secondary income, the European Central Bank reported. The current account deficit widened to a seasonally adjusted EUR 6 billion from EUR 2 billion in March. In the twelve months to April, the current account recorded a surplus of EUR 182 billion or 1.5 percent of euro area GDP, compared with a surplus of EUR 316 billion or 2.7 percent of GDP in the same period last year.

**Global Indices:** The Dow jumped 641.47 points or 2.2 percent to 30,530.25, the Nasdaq surged 270.95 points or 2.5 percent to 11,069.30 and the S&P 500 spiked 89.95 points or 2.5 percent to 3,764.79.

**Indian Economy:** Indian private equity (PE) investments reached US\$ 70 billion in 2021, with over 2,000 deals, up 87% from the volumes recorded in 2022. According to Bain & Company's annual India Private Equity Report 2022, Consumer Tech and IT/ITES sectors together accounted for about 60% of the year's deal value at nearly US\$ 44 billion. The number of large cheque size investments increased significantly in 2022 with 11 deals for more than US\$ 1 billion, including Flipkart, Hexaware, and Mphasis, compared to six in 2020.

**Equity Market:** The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, up 934.23 points or 1.81% to 52,532.07. The Nifty 50 index gained 288.65 points or 1.88% to 15,638.80.

Corporate News: Hero MotoCorp has further strengthened its commitment and operations in Turkiye with the introduction of Euro-5 compliant variants of its three globally popular products. The range of Hero MotoCorp products in the Turkiye include the Xpulse 200 4V motorcycle and Dash 110, Dash 125 scooters. Som Distilleries & Breweries' mainline Beer Brand "Hunter" had a market share of 55% in the premium beer segment in May 2022 in Madhya Pradesh. The market share is the highest amongst all the premium beer manufacturers in the state.
