Global Economy: The US Fed policymakers lifted the benchmark overnight lending rate by a quarter of a percentage point to a range of 2.00% to 2.25%. The US central bank still foresees another rate hike in December, three more next year, and one increase in 2020. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) maintained its developing Asia growth outlook for this year, but trimmed its projection for next year on escalating trade tensions. In an update of its flagship annual economic publication, the Asian Development Outlook, the bank said growth remains stable across most of developing Asia due to robust domestic demand, buoyant oil and gas prices, and a consolidation of India's growth rebound. According to the ADB, the region will grow 6% this year and by 5.8% next year. While the forecast for 2018 was maintained, the outlook for next year was trimmed from 5.9% earlier. UK retailers reported a slower pace of growth in sales volumes in September and expect it to remain so again next month, the latest Distributive Trades Survey from the Confederation of British Industry showed Wednesday. The retail sales balance fell to 23% in September from 29% in August.

**Global Equities:** Investors were cautious after the US Federal Reserve's decision on interest rates. Commodities also slipped on profit selling.

**Indian Economy:** As per the First Advance Estimates, total production of Kharif Foodgrains during 2018-19 is estimated at 141.59 million tonnes. This is higher by 0.86 million tonnes as compared to last year's Kharif foodgrains production of 140.73 million tonnes. Further, kharif foodgrain production is 11.94 million tonnes more than the average production of five years (2012-13 to 2016-17) of 129.65 million tonnes. The cumulative rainfall in the country during the monsoon season i.e. 01st June to 12th September, 2018 has been 8% lower than Long Period Average (LPA).

**Equity Markets:** Local stocks yet again saw some selling pressure. Key equity indices resumed decline after previous session's gains, weighed down by IT and FMCG shares. The Nifty managed to stay afloat above the key 11,000 level. Benchmarks traded with a negative bias for most part of the session as volatility creeped in a day ahead of expiry of derivative contracts for the month of September.

Corporate News: Reliance Industrial Investments & Holdings, the wholly owned subsidiary of Reliance Industries has subscribed to 40,58,647 Compulsorily Convertible Preferred Shares of NetraDyne Inc., USA (NetraDyne) at USD 1.97110 per share, for cash aggregating to USD 8 million. IZMO announced that under its (proposed) wholly owned subsidiary company, Hughes Precision Manufacturing, the company has received the license to Manufacture and Proof Test Military Calibre Ammunition under the Arms Act, 1959 and the Arms Rules, 2016 from the Ministry of Home Affairs. Sugar stocks could be in focus as spot Sugar prices extended recent gains following media reports that state government has decided to provide soft loans worth Rs 4000 crore to sugar mills through the nationalised and other banks. Maruti Suzuki India has partnered with Zydus Hospitals, a leading provider of healthcare services, to set up a modern Polyclinic (Health centre) facility at Becharaji. India's economy continues on a robust growth path, the Asian Development Bank (ADB) said Wednesday. However, depreciation of the rupee and volatile external financial markets pose challenges, the multilateral lending agency added, in an update of its flagship annual economic publication, the Asian Development Outlook (ADO) 2018.
